1. SMARTHOMING: SIMPLE WAYS TO START SAVING

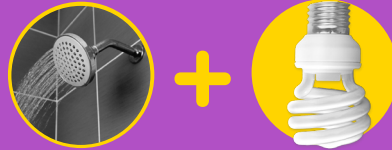


As a start, you can apply some smarthoming, no-cost habits that will save you money.

THESE LITTLE INVESTMENTS CAN GO A LONG WAY TOWARDS SAVING YOU MONEY.

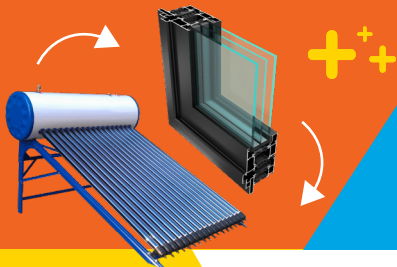


3. INVEST A LITTLE SAVE A LOT
